As a courtesy, RMANJ staff may ask you to wait for your appointment in a consult room. Please remember that the employees at RMANJ cannot supervise any children.

Since both parents must be occupied during some visits, children should not be brought to appointments for egg retrieval, embryo transfer or surgery.
